An example of presentation slide made to the standards

- Prepare the slides in Microsoft PowerPoint or Adobe Acrobat
- Use simple 24 point fonts or larger. Sans serif fonts are preferable (Arial, Computer modern, etc)
- Put as much information on your slide as your audience can absorb in one minute
- Do not overcrowd the slide, use 14 lines at most. You can expand some points in your lecture
- Use simple background. It is important that your slide be easily readable by the entire audience
- Avoid the use of too much animation effects.
- Use equations sparingly, and size them appropriately:

$$\int_{0}^{r_{2}} F(r, \varphi) dr d\varphi = [\sigma r_{2} / (2\mu_{0})].$$

Tips for your presentation

- Rehearse with an audience before coming to the presentation
- Use the laser pointer, if possible.
- Speak from your slides, not from a prepared written speech
- Talk to the audience, not to the screen
- Please, respect the schedule
- Leave some time for questions
