MOSCHYTZ, George S, Professor, Head of the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department at the Bar-Ilan University in Israel. Present interests include analog and digital, sampled-data, and adaptive filters, for communication systems. Earlier Professor Moschytz was with RCA Labs in Zürich, Bell Telephone Labs, Holmdel, NJ, where he supervised a group designing analog and digital integrated circuits for data communications, and at ETH, Zürich, as Professor and Director of the Institute for Signal and Information Processing. Author of *"Linear Integrated Networks: Fundamentals"* and *"Linear Integrated Networks: Design"*, and co-author of the *"Active Filter Design Handbook"*, and *"Adaptive Filter"* (in German). Editor of *"MOS Switched-Capacitor Filters: Analysis and Design"*, and co-editor of *"Tradeoffs in Analog Design"*. Authored many papers in the field of network theory, design, and analysis, and holds numerous patents in these areas. Professor Moschytz has held the position of president of the IEEE Circuit and Systems Society, and is an elected member of the Swiss Academy of Engineering Sciences. He is a Life-Fellow of the IEEE, and has received several IEEE awards, including the IEEE CAS Education Award.
